N.B. MAPLE SYRUP PRODUCERS PROTEST AGAINST GOVERNMENT OF NEW BRUNSWICK'S WALL OF SILENCE

New Brunswick, January 10th, 2022 – Members of the New Brunswick Maple Syrup Association (NBMSA) will be peacefully <u>protesting on January 13th</u> at the Maple Leaf - Centennial Park in Saint-Quentin.

It's been 2 years since the NBMSA and its member-producers have requested 12,000 additional hectares on Crown land to increase their annual maple syrup production to meet global demand.

The province has provided <u>no answers</u> to our request.

Enough with the silent treatment. We demand our fair share of Crown land allocations.
